

The Jefferson County Landmarks Commission met on Monday, August 11, at 10:00 A.M., at the Jefferson County Planning Commission's Offices. Those present were Miss Emily Stanley, Mrs. Leeds K. Riely, Dr. John Washington, and Mr. Archie Franzen.

The members reviewed the plans prepared by the architectural firm of Pickett, Siess and Hook of Falls Church, for renovations proposed for the Jefferson County Court House. Additional office space, fire escapes and a sprinkler system were discussed. The Commission repaired to the Court House yard for a visual examination of the area planned for an interconnecting structure between the Court House and the Moffett structure.

The members next met with County Court member Tom Mentzer who explained the background and need for the changes. The Commission was assured that little violation to the historic structure's fabric would occur due to the changes proposed.

Mr. Franzen suggested that the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation be contacted since the structure is listed on the National Register.
