This is a 3-bay brick farmhouse with laterally-oriented gable roof of standing-seam metal and interior gable-end brick chimneys. The centered entry door on the facade incorporates a single paneled door with sidelights. Fenestration is flat-topped, 9/6 and 6/6, with paint "ghosts" indicating the former residence of exterior operable shutters. Shed-roofed brick section on rear and non-historic shed-roofed wood frame addition on right elevation.

Several agricultural dependencies are associated with the property, including a side-aisle crib of wood and a substantial 1920s dairy barn with a gambrel roof, roof vents, a silo, and an attached milk house of concrete block. In addition, a small stone dependency is nearby, perhaps a former slave house; it appears vacant and unused.
