Statement of Significance	
This property appears eligible for the National Register under Criterion C for <i>architecture</i> , as an early nineteenth-century Jefferson County Federal-style farmhouse, although this preliminary evaluation would have to be confirmed by an inspection of the interior and the concurrence of the SHPO. It stands on a portion of Samuel Washington's "Harewood" property and was built by William Timberlake. It was purchased by Charles Snyder in 1889 and remains in the Snyder family.
